## Cambridgeshire Volunteer Awards

### About the Awards

Volunteers enrich our lives and our communities in so many ways, through a huge range of activities.

This is your chance to nominate an individual or group that deserve to be recognised for their outstanding contribution to volunteer work.

### Entry Conditions

Nominations must be submitted on the Cambridgeshire Volunteer Awards nomination form.

Nominations will only be accepted if received on or before 30 June 2008.

Self-nominations or nominations by family members will not be accepted.

Nominations not signed by the nominator will be invalid.

Nomination forms will not be returned.

### Individual Categories:

***Commitment and Inspiration*** An award for volunteers who have shown true dedication and been an inspiration to others.

***Impact*** For volunteers whose work has transformed lives, environments or communities.

### Group Categories:

***Large Volunteer or Community Organisation of the Year***

Nominees must operate on county or district wide basis.

***Small Volunteer or Community Organisation of the Year***

Nominees must operate on a local basis.

## Cambridgeshire Volunteer Awards

### Submitting Nominations

Nominations must be made by completing the Cambridgeshire Volunteer Awards nomination form which can be downloaded from [www.communitylifeawards.org.uk](http://www.communitylifeawards.org.uk). Those without access to the internet should request a copy of the form by contacting the Community Life Awards Co-ordinator whose details can be found overleaf.

Please fill in as much detail as possible to give your nominee the best chance of being selected for an award and return the form as indicated.

### How your entry will be assessed

The Cambridgeshire Volunteer Awards judges are provided by the Awards' sponsors, Cambridgeshire County Council.

The judges will evaluate each nomination received on its own merit against a matrix of set criteria.

Award winners will be notified by letter at the end of July 2008 and will be invited, with a guest, to attend the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Community Life Awards Dinner which will take place on Tuesday 2 September 2008.

During this evening event, which celebrates all aspects of community life in Cambridgeshire, they will be presented with their award by the Lord Lieutenant of Cambridgeshire.

### Prizes

Volunteer Award winners will receive a commemorative award in recognition of their efforts.

Plus a framed certificate and a photograph of their award being presented.
